Did you know that you can get a low-interest loan from the Village of New Berlin?

Q: Who is eligible to apply?

A: Anyone who owns property in the Village with appropriate credit status. Q: How much can be borrowed?

A: Up to \$20,000 for residential properties, \$30,000 for commercial properties.

Q: What is the interest rate?

A: Currently 2.50% fixed.

Q: How long does one have to repay?

A: Up to 3 or 5 years for residential, depending on the amount of loan.

Up to 5 years for commercial.

Q: What type of projects may qualify?

A: Virtually any DIY or professionally contracted project may be approved.
